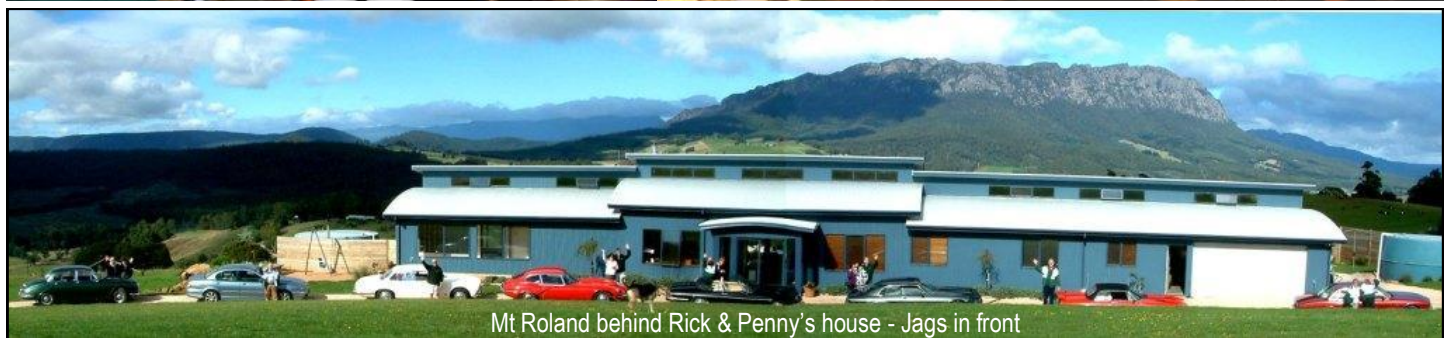
We then got on our way and we were along side Garry. I put the window down and asked what he was doing and he said "I come from a big island", I shook my head and drove away as the lights changed.
